

SECTION 01 11 00 - SUMMARY OF WORK

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 WORK COVERED BY CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- A. The work generally involves roadway improvements to Boynton Street which include planing, surface treatment, widening, and bituminous concrete overlay. Other miscellaneous work include the adjustment of manholes and valve boxes, curb replacement, shoulder work, seeding and mulching, and the installation of traffic control stripe and markings.

1.2 WORK SEQUENCE

- A. Contractor shall not complete any work during the morning and afternoon dropoff /pickup times for the school. Coordination with the Owner and Headland School System shall be done prior to starting work on Boynton Street.
- B. Contractor option, but planned so that all work will be completed in the days allocated in the Agreement.

1.3 CONTRACTOR'S USE OF PREMISES

- A. Contractor shall limit his use of the premises for work and for storage, to allow for Owner and Headland School System occupancy and continuous operation of all facilities in the work area.
- B. Contractor shall coordinate use of premises under direction of Owner and Headland School System.
- C. Contractor shall assume full responsibility for the protection and safekeeping of products under this contract, stored on the site.
- D. Contractor shall move any stored products, under Contractor's control, which interfere with operations of the Owner and Headland School System.

1.4 OWNER OCCUPANCY

- A. The Owner, Headland School System, and public will occupy the work areas during the entire period of construction for the conduct of normal operations. Cooperate with Owner's and Henry County School Board Representative in all construction operations to minimize conflict, and to facilitate Owner, School Board, and public usage.

1.5 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

- A. The Contractor shall develop and implement, prior to the start of work, an emergency response plan. This plan, at a minimum, shall include how an immediate response will be achieved.

Contractor shall provide the name and telephone number of a local representative that can respond to emergencies on a 24-hour per day basis.

1.6 WORK HOURS

- A. The Work shall be performed only during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday except as noted in Paragraph 1.2A. Work may be performed outside this work window under the following conditions:
1. Contractor shall submit written request to Owner requesting different work hours and stating the reason for the request, including why it would be in the best interest of the Owner to approve the request.
  2. Owner gives written approval of the request.
