# SECTION 01 11 00 - SUMMARY OF WORK

PART 1 - GENERAL

#### 1.1 SUMMARY

- A. Section includes the following:
  - 1. Work by Contractor.
  - 2. Contractor Use of Site and Premises.
  - 3. Owner Occupancy.
  - 4. Quantities.
  - 5. Emergency Response Plan.
  - 6. Background Checks, Photo ID, and Marking of Vehicles

### 1.2 WORK BY CONTRACTOR

- A. The work to be performed under this Contract shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals and performing all work required to construct complete in place and ready to operate the improvements shown in the Contract Documents. These improvements include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - 1. The work to be performed under this Contract consists of replacement of approximately 3,600 linear feet of 8" to 15" sanitary sewer pipe by open-cut method, rehabilitation of approximately 700 linear feet of 12" to 14" sanitary sewer pipe by cured-in-place-pipe method, replacement of approximately 900 linear feet of 12" sanitary sewer pipe by pipe-bursting method, and all other related appurtenances.
- B. All work described above shall be performed as shown on the Drawings and as specified.
- C. Project Location.
  - 1. The equipment and materials to be furnished will be installed at the locations shown on the Drawings.

### 1.3 CONTRACTOR USE OF SITE AND PREMISES

- A. Limit use of site and premises as follows:
  - 1. Limit use to public rights-of-way and easements.
  - 2. Owner occupancy to maintain any and all utilities or other property under their control.
  - 3. Continual access for residents and business owners to their property.

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#### 1.4 PARTIAL OWNER OCCUPANCY

- A. The Owner will use existing rights-of-way to which these improvements are being made and will continue operation during the period of construction.
- B. There shall not be any interruption in service. The Contractor is responsible for fines assessed due to his activities.
- C. Whenever, in the opinion of the Engineer, any section or portion of the work or any structure is in suitable condition, it may be put into use upon the written order of the Engineer and such usage will not be held in any way as an acceptance of said work or structure, or any part thereof, or as a waiver of any of the provisions of these Specifications and the Contract. Pending final completion and acceptance of the Work, all necessary repairs and replacements, due to defective materials or workmanship or operations of the Contractor, for any section of the work so put into use shall be performed by the Contractor at Contractor's own expense.

# 1.5 QUANTITIES

A. The Owner reserves the right to alter the quantities of work to be performed or to extend or shorten the improvements at any time when and as found necessary, and the Contractor shall perform the work as altered, increased or decreased. Payment for such increased or decreased quantity will be made in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. No allowance will be made for any change in anticipated profits nor shall such changes be considered as waiving or invalidating any conditions or provisions of the Contract and Bond.

### 1.6 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

A. The Contractor shall develop and implement, prior to the start of work, an emergency response plan for handling spills and overflow of sewage or other materials that will damage the environment. This plan shall include how an immediate response will be achieved. Contractor shall provide the name and telephone number of a local representative that can respond to emergencies on a 24-hour per day basis.

# 1.7 BACKGROUND CHECKS, PHOTO ID, & MARKING OF VEHICLES

- A. Contractor shall require criminal background checks to be performed as a requirement of employment. The same applies for all subcontractors. Provide proof to the Engineer prior to the start of work that all employees scheduled to work on-site have passed a criminal background check.
- B. Contractor shall require all employees and subcontractors who work on-site to wear photo ID badges that include employee name, employee picture, and company name.
- C. All trucks and other vehicles used by contractor and subcontractor employees much be clearly marked with the name of the associated business.
